


## Lesson Plan: A 'hole' lot of clouds




The ring is divided into 11 segments, each with a cloud image and a label:

- Top (Blue):** Ci (Cirrus), Cs (Cirrocumulus), Cc (Cirrostratus)
- Middle (Yellow):** Ac (Altostratus), As (Altostratus), Ns (Nimbostratus)
- Bottom (Green):** Cu (Cumulus), St (Stratus), Cb (Cumulonimbus)

Scissors icons are placed around the ring to indicate where to cut out the segments.
